

## **SAMPLE LETTER TO SENATOR BILL NELSON**

Dear Senator Nelson:

As a victim of Chinese drywall, it has come to my attention that you are a true advocate for people in my situation. During the past year, you have assisted victims with the investigation of problems and the collateral issues associated with Chinese drywall.

Recently, I found out about your efforts concerning mortgage protection, including both the letter to the Secretary for the Department of the Treasury, Timothy F. Geithner, and a resolution (H.Con.Res.197) passed in the United States House of Representatives and the United States Senate encouraging banks and mortgage servicers to work with families affected by contaminated drywall to allow temporary forbearance without penalty on payments on their home mortgages.

Since you have been an advocate for mortgage protection of victims of Chinese drywall, I now write to you concerning my individual situation. (Please describe your individual situation, the reason your case is in need of advocacy and what steps you have taken in an effort to make the lender work with you through your ordeal with Chinese drywall).

On behalf of myself and all the other victims of Chinese drywall, I hope to hear from your office soon. I hope you can help me and my family in this situation. However, most important, I hope that you can pass a law, not a resolution, that will permanently protect victims of Chinese Drywall from the banks who are trying to take their homes.
